## A message from Ruth

Cows are not my specialist subject!

This week however I have thought quite a lot about them! My thoughts were triggered by Jesus' words recorded in Matthew 11 - 'My yoke is easy and my burden is light.'

Jesus' burden may be light but the challenges of the world are very often anything but.

My recently acquired cow knowledge reveals that two cows can pull more than the sum of what each cow can pull on their own, they really are 'stronger together'.

Being yoked to Jesus gives us the strength to keep going and to shoulder heavier burdens than we could ever do on our own. But what if we also allow ourselves to be yoked to others?

The very heaviest loads were pulled by multiple pairs of yoked cows. If I am finding my burden heavy, who is there around me who might help me pull it, who will willingly come alongside me and help shoulder the burden?

And in turn, who am I being called to come alongside? Whose burden can I help to carry?

I may not know much about cows, but I do know that they work alongside each other, following the lead of the most senior/experienced animal, to carry more than they could ever shoulder alone.

So, as you pick up burdens today, remember to look around for the other cows!
