A message from Duncan

One of the disciplines we are called to as followers of Jesus is to kindle an ever present spirit of thankfulness in our lives. Upon my return from sabbatical, perhaps unsurprisingly, a spirit of thankfulness comes quite naturally: "I will sing the Lord's praise, for he has been good to me." (Ps 13.6). I will be delighted to share with you all, in the near future, some of what I have got up to over the last few months at an evening gathering, perhaps on a Sunday evening in September - I will keep you posted once I've caught up with what else is happening around here!

I owe a great debt, and am profoundly thankful, to all those who enabled me to take this sabbatical, and for the financial assistance in meeting some of the costs. Thank you to all of you who have given sacrificially of your time in leading services and preaching more than your usual share; for all the work behind the scenes in ensuring that the life of both parishes ran as smoothly as possible; that pastoral needs were met as they arose; and for all those who, in the words of someone who was reporting back to me, simply got on with what needed to be done without anyone knowing. Thank you so much.

I realise it is rare in this world to have the opportunity to take a breather from normal routine to rest, retreat and be refreshed: a chance to be reminded why we are doing what we are doing, and for the Christian, who we are doing it for. At times in our relationship with God we can become jaded, disillusioned and discouraged, and it is water to the soul to be reminded that God is good, he holds us fast, and his purposes for us will be fulfilled as we surrender our lives to him. One song has impressed itself upon myself and Carmen over these past months (<u>listen here</u>) and expresses my heart and my hope for us all as we continue to serve Jesus day by day:

That I put my faith in Jesus

He's faithful through generations


