Nigeria, Burkina Faso, DRC, Sudan, Niger, Mali, Guinea, Cameroon... are countries about which we do not hear a great deal in our UK mainstream news. In fact there are many, many newsworthy stories coming out of sub-Saharan Africa; a shockingly large number of these relate to our Christian brothers and sisters who are being persecuted in horrific ways for following the Lord Jesus.

We can all do something. Here are a couple of ideas:-

- 1) **Pray on your own**: there is a wealth of prayer resources available from Tear Fund, Open Doors, etc.
- 2) **Pray with other people:** for example the 'International Day of Prayer for the Persecuted Church' will be held at Open Doors in Witney on Saturday 15 November, 8am 8pm. You can attend for as much or for as little time as you like. (I am going for part of the afternoon).



There will be a bulk order placed in early November to maximise savings on printing and postage

costs and The Friends are making the book available to purchase at <u>cost price</u> (including a share of the postage costs). The final price will depend on the volume of orders received but is likely to be in the region of £25-£30 per book and we require a £10 non-refundable deposit per book to secure an order with

the balance payable on delivery. Please note that as The Friends will not be profiting from this publication then all books ordered must be paid for in full upon delivery or our charity will sustain the loss as we have to pay for the orders in advance. Initial reactions from those who have seen the book are very favourable and we hope to be able to distribute copies by early December.
